3. **School Attendance** - Missing just two days of school – for any reason – can be a problem for kids in a number of ways. Children who are chronically absent in kindergarten and first grade are less likely to read at grade level by the third grade. For older students, being chronically absent is strongly associated with failing at school – even more than low grades or test scores. When absences add up, these students are more likely to be suspended and drop out of high school. Take any warning you receive seriously. Why? The consequences of too many absences are serious not only for students, but also for parents! Schools handle minor truancy with warning letters, parent-teacher conferences, and other means. However, in some states, parents can be fined when their kids miss too much school.
