RESOLUTION NO. 07-20

RESOLUTION ORDERING AN ELECTION, REQUESTING COUNTY ELECTIONS DIVISION
TO CONDUCT THE ELECTIONS, REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION OF THE ELECTION, AND
SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

CALIENTE UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, CALIENTE UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT HAS 4 OPENINGS FOR BOARD SEATS
WITH 1 SHORT TERM, OF 2 YEARS , AND 3 LONG TERM OF 4 YEARS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code § 5322, whenever a school district election is ordered, the governing board of the district or the officer authorized to make such designations shall, concurrently with or after the order of election, but no less than 123 days prior to the date set for the election in the case of an election for governing board members, or at least 88 days prior to the date of the election in the case of an election on a measure, including a bond measure, by resolution delivered to the county superintendent of schools and the officer conducting the election specify the date of the election and the purpose of the election;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code § 10002, the governing body of any city or district may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors of the county to permit the county elections official to render specified services to the city or district relating to the conduct of an election. The city or district shall reimburse the county in full for the services performed upon presentation of a bill to the city or district; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code § 10400, whenever two or more elections, including bond elections, of any legislative or congressional district, public district, city, county, or other political subdivision are called to be held on the same day, in the same territory, or in territory that is in part the same, they may be consolidated upon the order of the governing body or bodies or officer or officers calling the elections; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code § 10403, whenever an election called by a district, city or other political subdivision for the submission of any question, proposition, or office to be filled is to be consolidated with a statewide election, and the question, proposition, or office to be filled is to appear upon the same ballot as that provided for that statewide election, the district, city or other political subdivision shall, at least 88 days prior to the date of the election, file with the board of supervisors, and a copy with the elections official, a resolution of its governing board requesting the consolidation, and setting forth the exact form of any question, proposition, or office to be voted upon at the election, as it is to appear on the ballot. Upon such request, the Board of Supervisor may order the consolidation. The resolution requesting the consolidation shall be adopted and filed at the same time as the adoption of the ordinance, resolution, or order calling the election;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code § 5342 and Elections Code§10400, such election for school districts may be either completely or partially consolidated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that pursuant to Education Code § 5342 and Elections Code §§ 10400 and 10403, the governing body/board of trustees of the CALIENTE UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT hereby orders an election be called and consolidated with any and all elections also called to be held on NOV. 3, 2026 within the same territory or in territory that is in part the same as the territory of the school district, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that pursuant to Elections Code § 10002 said governing body/board of trustees hereby requests that Board of Supervisors of the County of Kern to permit the Kern County Elections Department to provide any and all services necessary for conducting an election and agrees to pay for said services in full, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that pursuant to Education Code § 5322, the authority for the specifications of the election order, the governing body/board of trustees of the CALIENTE UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT hereby orders an election to be held with the following specification:

The election shall be held on Tuesday, Nov. 3, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Kern County Elections Department shall conduct the election to be held on Nov. 3, 2026 and submit to the electorate the following question:

BE IT FURTHER RESLOVED AND ORDERED that the Kern County Elections Department is requested

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED THAT voter approval requirement is Majority.
